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Title: An exploration of daysmetric mapping techniques for population data in Duval County

Abstract

Daysmetric mapping is much more focused technique to calculate population density. Using daysmetric mapping, individuals can create a more accurate representation of population distribution. Census data has great data but is not always as accurate being the information is spread through either block groups or tracts. These boundaries do not always reflect accurate locations of natural distribution and how it relates using residential land use, rather than a whole block or tract.
