

QUALIFYING WORDS AND PHRASES

Qualifying words and phrases modify the conditions which affect important ideas or situations. There are two kinds: *absolutes* and *sometimes* words. Absolutes mean 100% of the time and sometimes words mean undefined portions or numbers of times.

Absolute words and phrases:

no - all - never l always l only - ever l none - no one l forever - every time

Sometimes words and phrases:

few - many i occasionally i some i most - somewhat i sometimes i usually - nearly i always

EMPHASIS WORDS AND PHRASES

These clues indicate a **degree of importance** of ideas and events in relation to each other.

above all - less important - most important - key idea - more importantly the crux - main point - less so - a central fact - of significance

TIME AND ORDER WORDS AND PHRASES

Time and order words and phrases indicate specific organization patterns of ideas of ideas
